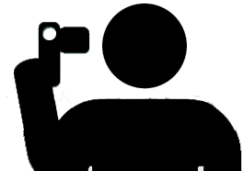

Internet Archive <http://archive.org>

The Internet Archive (IA) is a public nonprofit that was founded to build an "Internet library" for the purpose of offering permanent access to researchers, historians, and scholars of historical collections that exist in digital form. IA provides free storage and free serving of your videos, audio files, photos, text, PDFs and other media. Forever. No catches. Register the same email address as your Our Media registration.

Multimedia Publishers' interface to the IA and to consumers of their media. Register the same email address as your IA registration to upload your media to the IA through here.

Instant Gratification. Posts are immediately served. Record video in Macintosh Safari browser. Simultaneously cross post to Blogger, MovableType, Typepad, & WordPress websites, Internet Archive and the <http://del.icio.us/> social bookmarks site.

Vimeo <http://vimeo.com>

Instant Gratification. Posts are immediately served. Post to your blog or Post to Flickr, then to your blog.

Google Video <http://video.google.com>

New hosting opportunity. 24 hour delay to complete posts. But interesting graphical display with names and times, Thumbnails play in place, provide instant playback previews without downloading from their servers. Advantage of Google's ultra fast search engine to find videos.

For hosting photos to link to your blog.

FeedBurner <http://feedburner.com>

Publish using FeedBurner so people can subscribe to and download vids from your blog.

FeedForAll <http://feedforall.com>

PC & Mac RSS Feed Creation Tool. Edit, create and publish iTunes compatible RSS 2.0 feeds from your own non-blog centric website.

FireANT <http://getfireant.com>

FireANT is a free RSS video aggregator and media player available for Mac OS X and Windows XP. With FireANT, you can subscribe to any RSS 2.0 feed with enclosures. FireANT will automatically download fresh audio and video content for you to watch and listen to. It can playback any media format, and syncs audio files with iTunes so you can easily add them to your portable MP3 player and syncs video files for playback on your Sony PSP.

Mefedia <http://mefedia.com>

Mefedia.com is a free web based aggregator for videobloggers. It lets you subscribe to videobloggers and tag videos.

VlogDir <http://vlogdir.com>

A new Videoblog Directory Service that allows you to add a link to your videoblog along with descriptive details, RSS feeds for subscribers and also let's you attach media.

Vlogs Universe <http://videoblogging-universe.com>

See the most recently updated videoblogs, watch a preview clip, create your own interactive vlog roll.

VlogMap <http://vlogmap.org>

World map of videoblogs. Find vlogs near you, far away from you, add your feed, subscribe to feeds.

iTunes <http://apple.com/itunes>

Multimedia RSS client listing over 20,000 audio and video podcasts in an easily navigable directory. Automatically downloads subscribed to audio, video & PDF files to your hard drive for local playback. Syncs with and loads new videos automatically to your video enabled iPod.
